Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore He is able to save them to the uttermost that come to God by Him, seeing He ever lives to make intercession for them.

Bearing in mind that there is only ONE GOD and that our one God knows all things, it seems strange that Christ (Who is God) would be pleading our case before Father God since He has given us the means to readily come to Him through the shed blood and torn veil?

Greek scholars tell us that the word translated here as 'for' can be better translated here as 'toward'.

This would make a lot more sense as we see the Holy Spirit/Christ in us interceding Father's will towards us constantly. The doing of Father's thinking will save us from every interfering thought from our carnal minds. Every thought must come into the obedience of Christ. Father's love for us will not let us go unchanged!

Allow the Spirit of God by listening to that inner *still*, *small voice* of the Spirit which is Christ in you to achieve His purposes which will *change you from glory to glory into His image*.§
