## SHAKING HANDS WITH GOD!

To shake hands with another, the right hands are clasped together. It signifies that an agreement is made and that neither party will rescind on the arrangement. The clasping of the right hands is quite often accompanied with a spoken word which is actually a vow to see the contract fulfilled.

It has been over the centuries a legally binding agreement. The breaking of such an agreement had some harsh penalties.

**Isaiah 41:10** *Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee WITH THE RIGHT HAND of My righteousness.* In this verse we see God saying His right hand will uphold the one He is speaking with.

**Verse (13)** *For I the LORD thy God will hold THY RIGHT HAND, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee.* This verse a little while later declares that He (God) will hold your right hand! **So you see this is simply shaking hands with the Lord.**

The context of this agreement was that God would remove all fear and He would strengthen, help and uphold you. That was worth 'shaking on', right? §
